Prescriptions for chronic conditions

All plans:

You may fill 90-day scripts for maintenance medications at a CVS Pharmacy® location*.

- Medications include injectable, infused and select oral therapies.

- All Specialty Medications are required to be filled through CVS Specialty Pharmacy
- GLP-1's require preauthorization. There is no coverage for weight loss.

HealthSelect EPO - When do I pay?

Medical/behavioral claims:

- Show your providers your Aetna® ID card.
- If your visit has a copay assigned it, they will collect the copay at the time of service.
- If your visit is subject to the deductible/coinsurance, they will file the claim on your behalf.
- You can choose to pay with your FSA or out of pocket.

Pharmacy claims:

- Show the pharmacy your Aetna ID Card.
- Claims are processed in “real-time.”
- Providers will collect your copay at the time you pick up your medicine.
- You can choose to pay with your FSA or out of pocket right at the pharmacy.

HealthSave and HealthSave Basic Plans - When do I Pay?

Medical/behavioral claims:

- Show your providers your Aetna® ID card.
- They will generally bill Aetna first on your behalf.
 - ❖ Billing Aetna first ensures you get the negotiated rate and your deductible/coinsurance credit.
- Once Aetna processes the claim, we advise your provider how much is your member responsibility. The provider will bill you for your portion.
- You can choose to pay with your HSA or out of pocket.

Pharmacy claims:

- Show the pharmacy your Aetna ID Card.
- Claims are processed in “real-time.”
- You’ll receive your negotiated rate.
 - ❖ Once your deductible is met, you only pay a copay.
- You can choose to pay with your HSA or out of pocket right at the pharmacy.

Medical/Rx – network providers cost less

Use network providers: lower deductibles, lower out-of-pocket maximums, negotiated rates, no balance billing and coordinate with Aetna on your behalf.

Out-of-network providers cost more: You will be responsible for any charges above the plan's [recognized charges](#), and the charges the plan doesn't cover will not count toward your deductible or out-of-pocket maximum.

Know how to save by choosing the right places for care

Where you receive care can have a big impact on your cost. Your costs can vary quite a bit based on the type of facility you choose. Here are some tips:

Hospital-based care costs more, even at an in-network hospital. There can be a significant difference in cost between care at a facility affiliated with a hospital and a freestanding facility for procedures such as:

- Outpatient surgery
- X-rays/high-tech radiology (MRI/CAT scan)
- Endoscopies
- Physical therapy

For non-emergency care, you'll save time and pay much less if you visit your primary care provider (PCP), Teladoc Health, a walk-in clinic or an urgent care center instead of an ER.

Save on lab work by using an independent lab like Quest or Labcorp versus a hospital-affiliated lab.

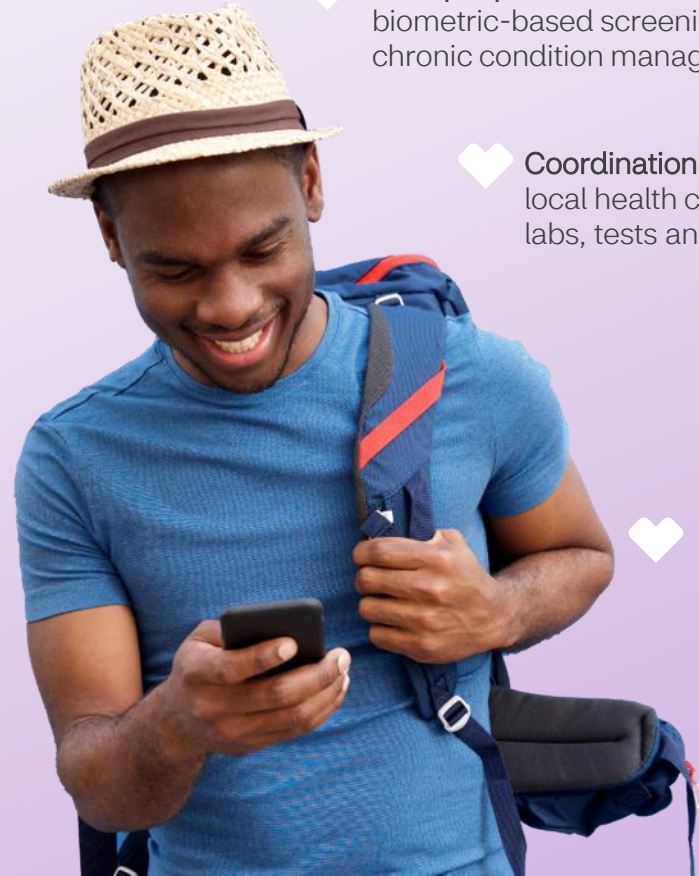

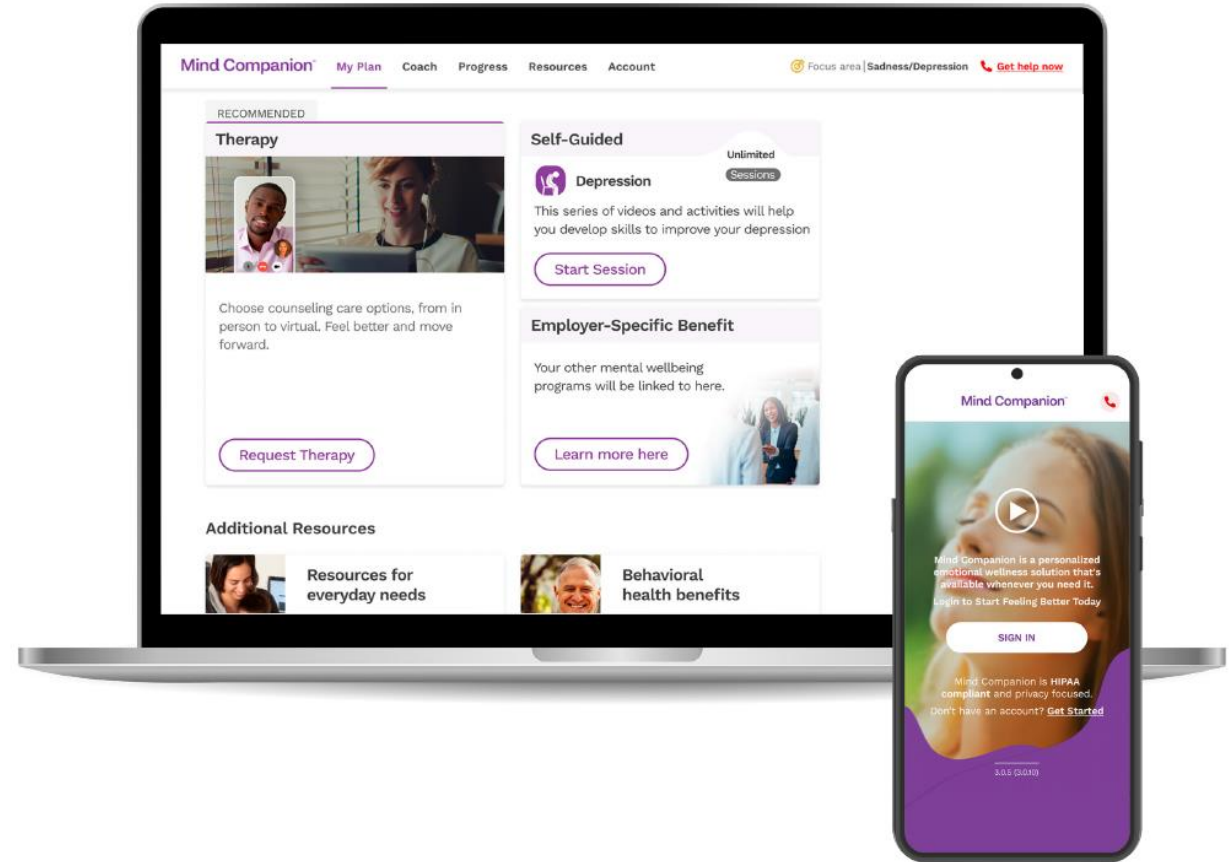

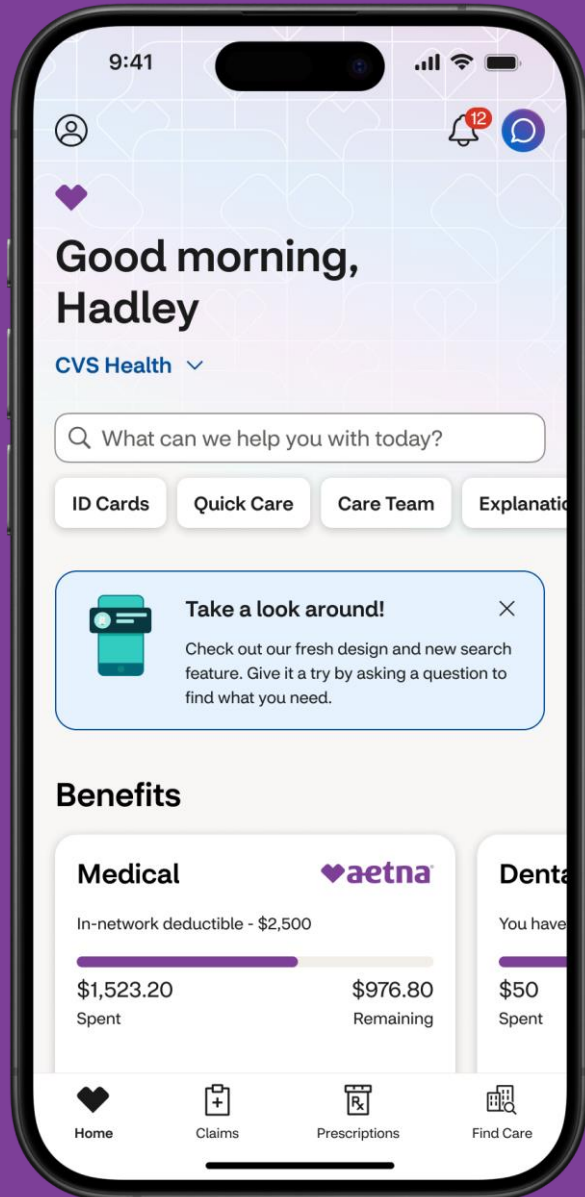

Medical/Rx – ways to save

- Use the cost estimator tool on [Aetna.com](https://www.aetna.com) before elective services.
- Call the 24-Hour Nurse Line 24/7 at 1-800-556-1555 (TTY: 711) for no-cost health information and support.
- Use Teladoc®, walk-in clinics or urgent care centers versus the emergency room whenever possible.
- When you need [lab services](#), use Quest Diagnostics or LabCorp. When you need imaging services, go to freestanding or diagnostic imaging centers instead of hospitals.
- For Rx, ask if there's an over-the-counter (OTC) equivalent, generic or preferred brand available.
 - See how much a drug will cost before you fill any new prescriptions – and check those you use now for generic additions or lower-cost tier options.
- Use mail order or pick up a 90-day supply of maintenance medications at a CVS Pharmacy® location. After the deductible, you'll pay two copays for a three-month supply of medicine.
- Engage with Nurse Care Managers and specialty Advocates for complex conditions, surgeries, treatment plans
- Make a smart choice when you need medical care. Go to your PCP, Teladoc, or a Walk-in Clinic for non-urgent care needs and only use the ER for life threatening emergencies.
